PRESIDENT MACRON ANNOUNCES A CURFEW FOR AT LEAST 4 WEEKS IN PARIS & SUBURBS

AND OTHER 8 METROPOLES FROM 9PM TO 6AM

USPA NEWS - While the Coronavirus epidemic is progressing exponentially in France, French President Emmanuel Macron addressed the French, via an interview on TF1 / France 2, conducted by Gilles Bouleau and Anne Sophie Pix, on October 14, in the hour from Prime Time, 8pm. President Macron, above all, announced the major measure of a curfew, which will be implemented in Paris and Ile-de-France, and other eight following metropolises

- Aix-Marseille
 - Île-de-France
 - Lyon
 - Grenoble
 - Saint-Étienne
 - Lille
 - Toulouse
 - Montpellier
- Rouen from 9pm to 6am, from Saturday October 17 at midnight. The curfew will be in place for a minimum of 4 weeks.

PDT MACRON ANNOUNCES A CURFEW FOR AT LEAST 4 WEEKS IN 8 METROPOLES FROM 9PM TO 6AM

Yesterday evening, the President of the Republic Emmanuel Macron, a Emmanuel Macron announced the establishment of a curfew from 9 pm to 6 am, from Saturday October 17, in Paris and the rest of the of France as eight (8) other metropolitan areas in France. It isAs the French head of state explained, is to "confine yourself" and apply the new measures put in place to curb the spread of COVID-19, in the areas most affected by the virus. This curfew will last for a minimum of 4 weeks and failure to respect the curfew hours will be punished with a fine of € 135, or even more for a repeat offense.-----

Restaurants, bars and theaters and shows will be closed from 9pm. Social assistance, in the form of financial paychecks will be paid to the most destitute, ie families who receive housing allowances and people living on minimum social income (RSA is € 559 "for a single person without any other income)-----

For holders of the following allowances, the specific solidarity allowance (ASS) and active solidarity income (RSA). This COVID-19 premium is 150 euros per household (single person or couple), plus 100 euros per child under 20 (i.e. 250 euros for a household with 1 child, 350 with 2 children, etc.) and also concerns certain disabled people, in particular recipients of the allowance for disabled adults (AAH), who meet these criteria (and therefore still for some to be defined) are concerned.
