The streets of the city are unrecognisable: cars immersed in the water when the streets seem deserted. The houses are surrounded by water-----

Here, dozens of families were evacuated, that is to say all the inhabitants almost. In another street, others board a kayak for the first time to go home. "There are times when we step too fishing. Then one has to be a reason and we expect the decline," said a disaster. In these villages, one no longer distinguishes streams from the mainland. A Thomery, wheat fields were swallowed up, houses are surrounded with water. Only the vegetation seems to float in the streets.-----
